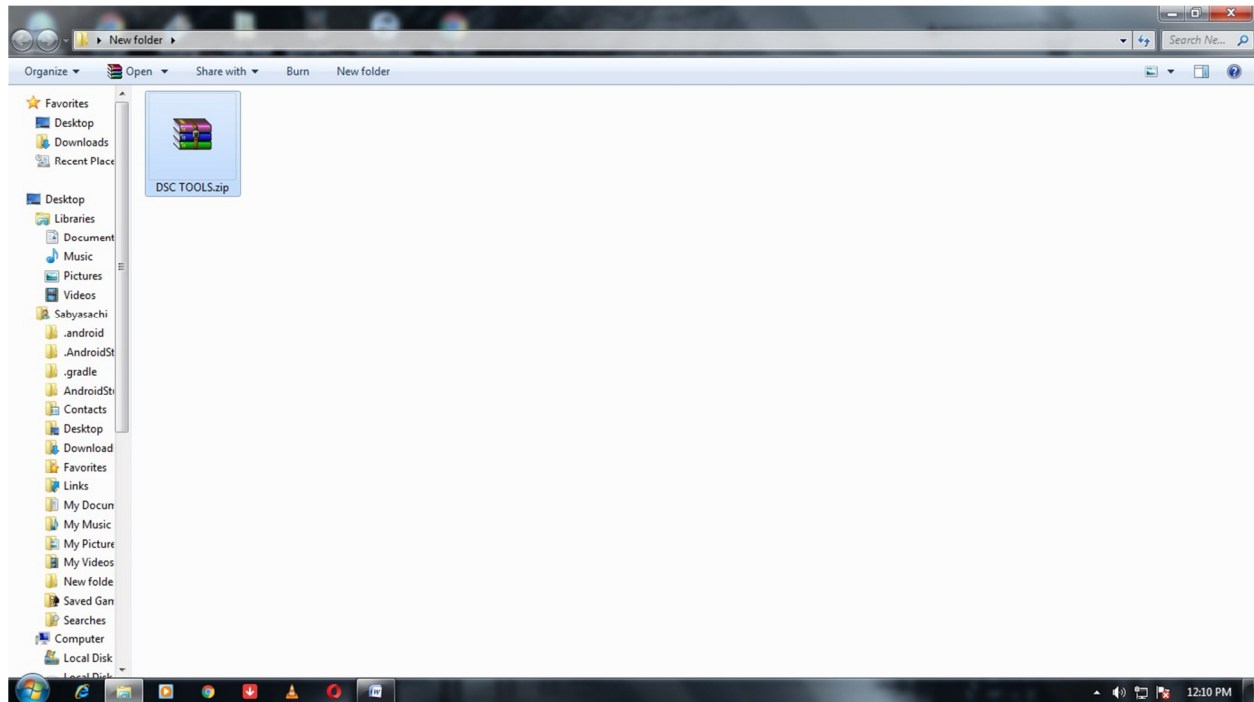

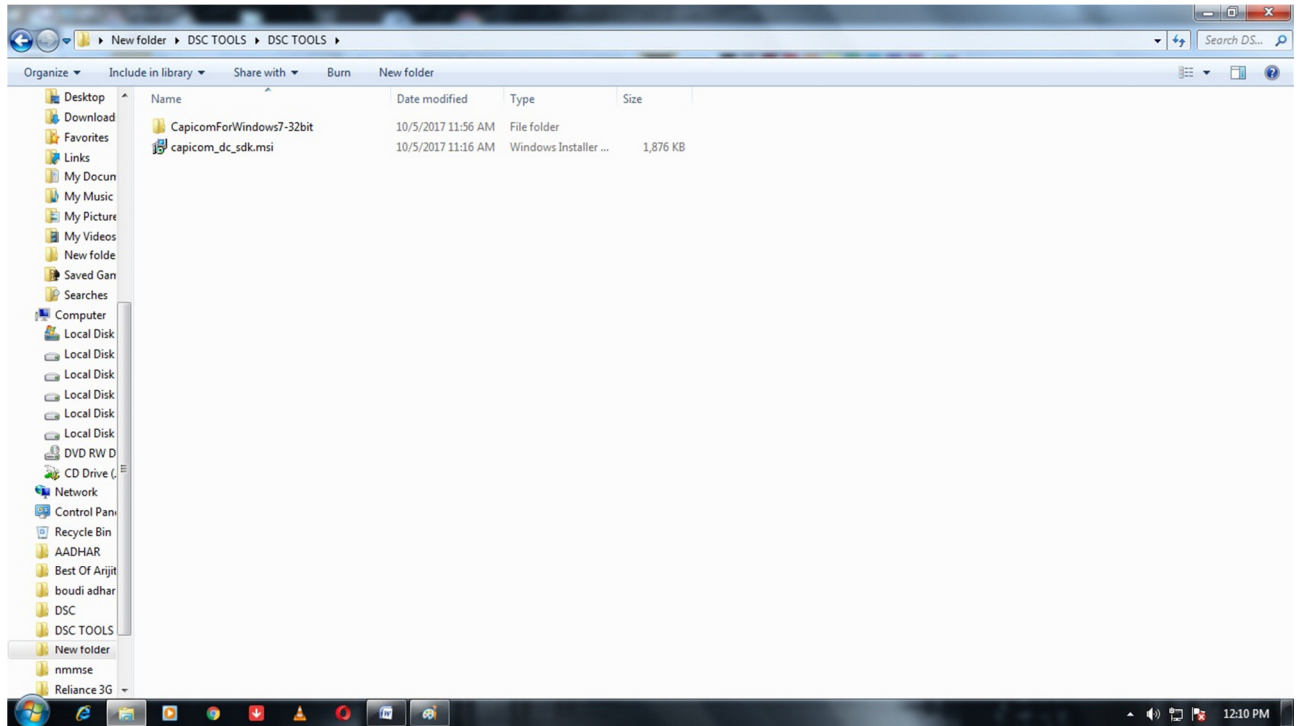
Verification of applications received through oasis.gov.in is now enabled with DSC (Digital signature certificate) token. Please follow the step to Set up the DSC verification environment in your computer.

Requirements: - Windows 7 32/64 bit Operating System and Internet Explorer 9

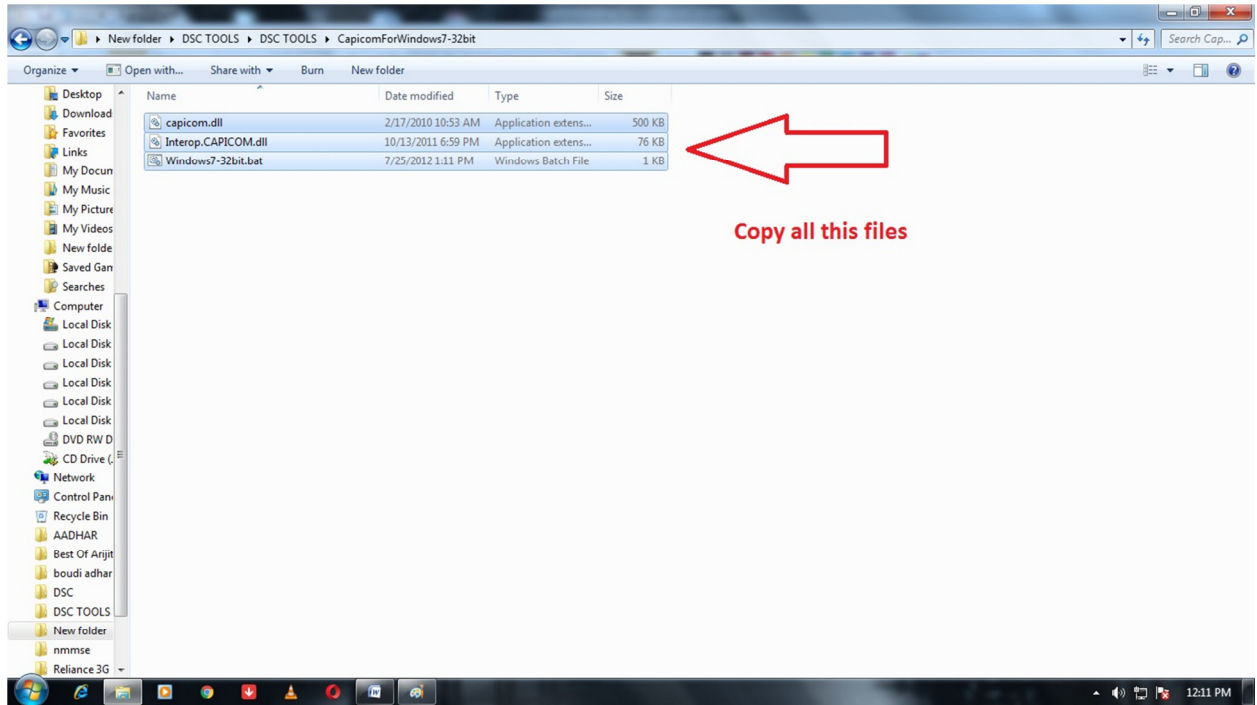
Step 1: Download DSC TOOLS from Dash board of BLOCK/ULB level users of oasis.gov.in.



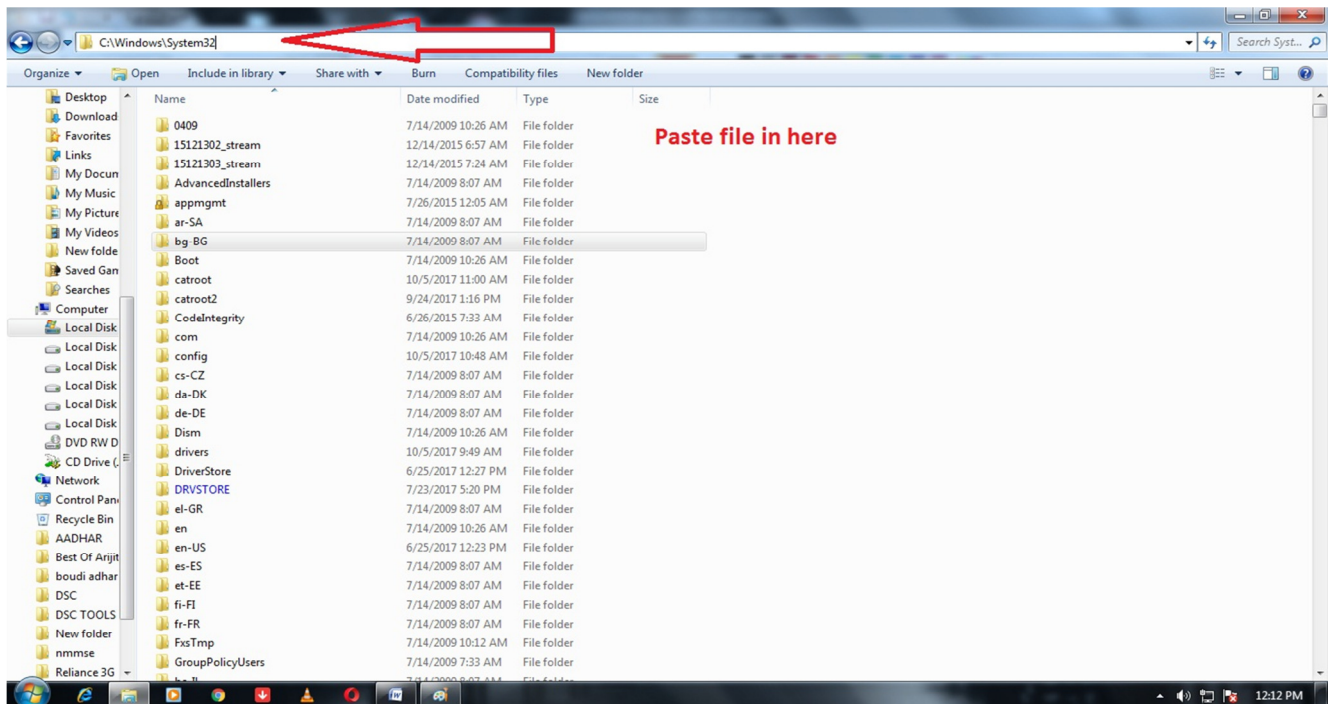
Step 2: Extract 'ZIP' file and explore it.



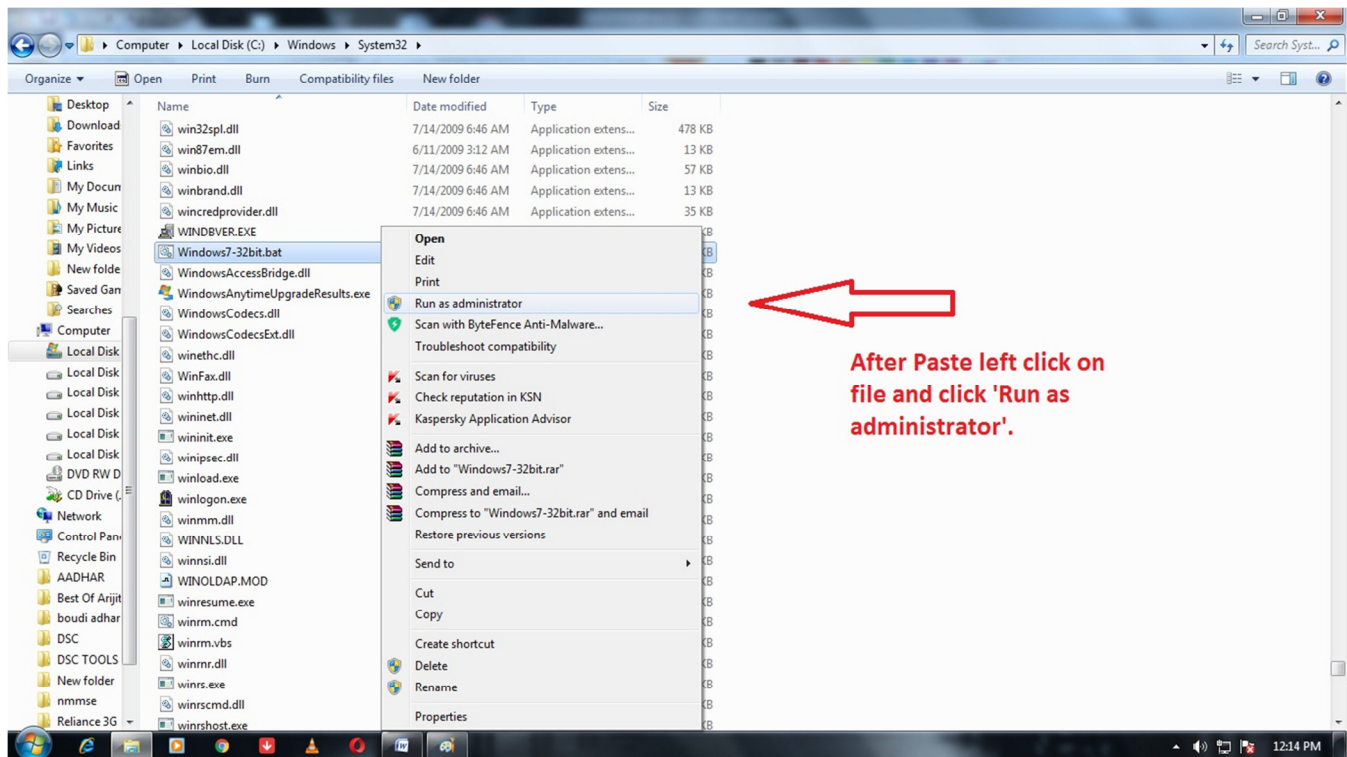
Step 3: Open 'CapicomForWindows7-32bit' folder and copy all files.

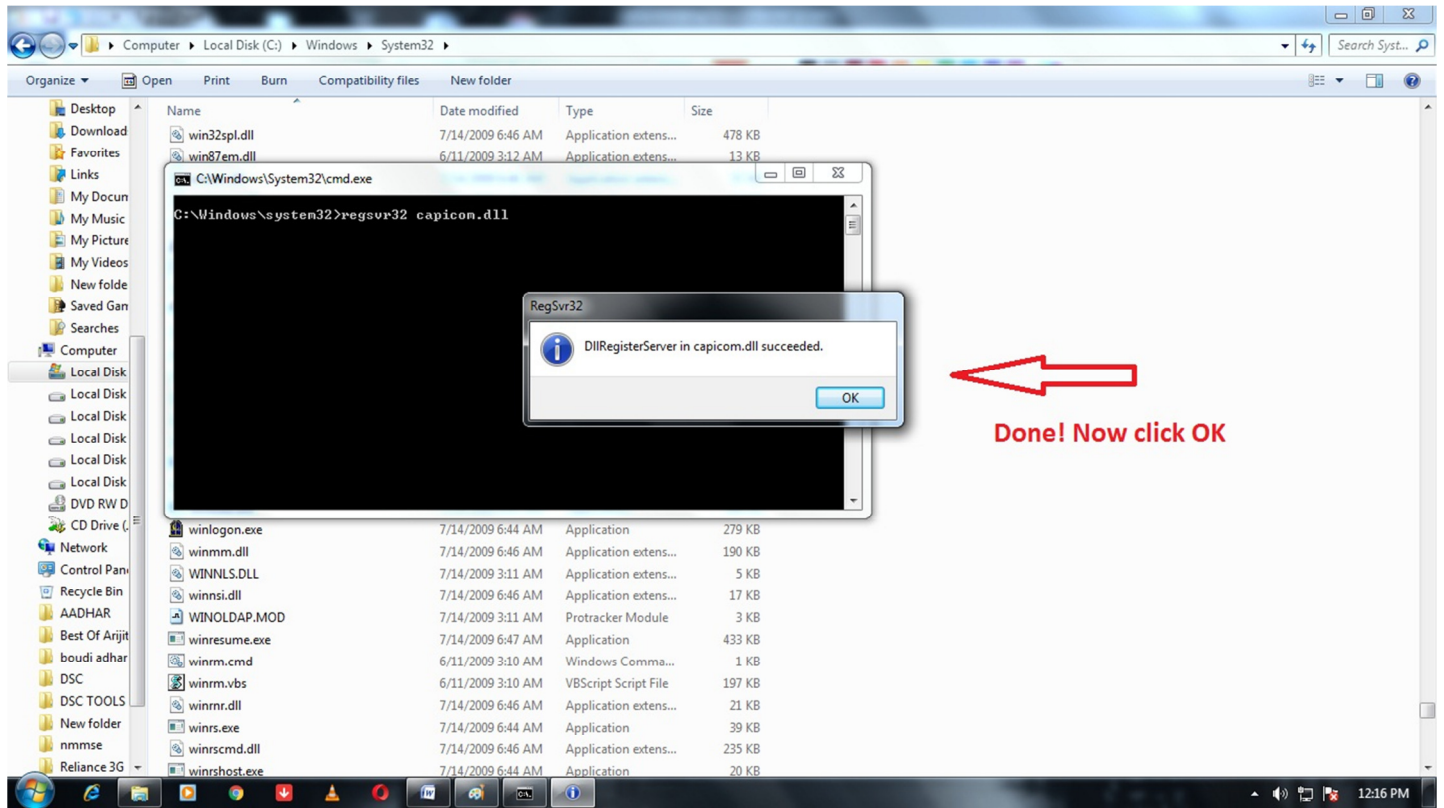


Step 4: Paste those files into "System32" Folder. Usually located at "C:\Windows\System32" path (Please check the path from your computer).



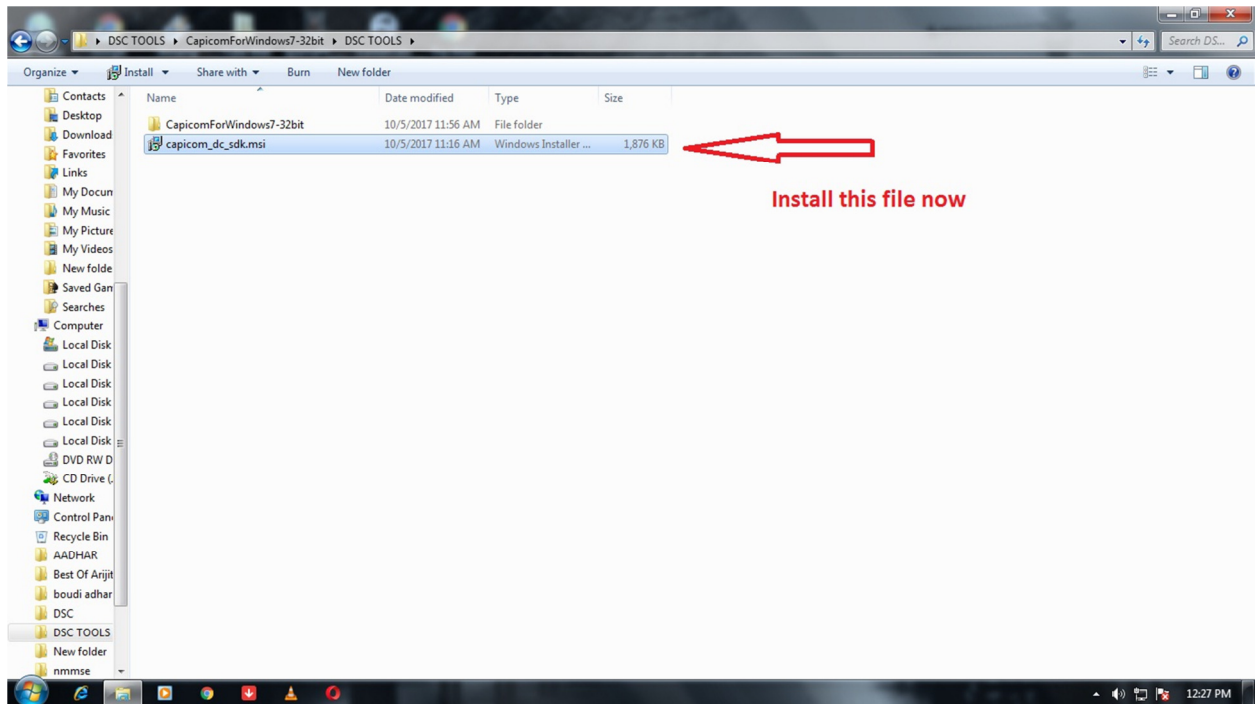
Step 5: Run "Windows7-32bit.bat" file as Administrator. When it's says 'Successfully Registered' then close it.



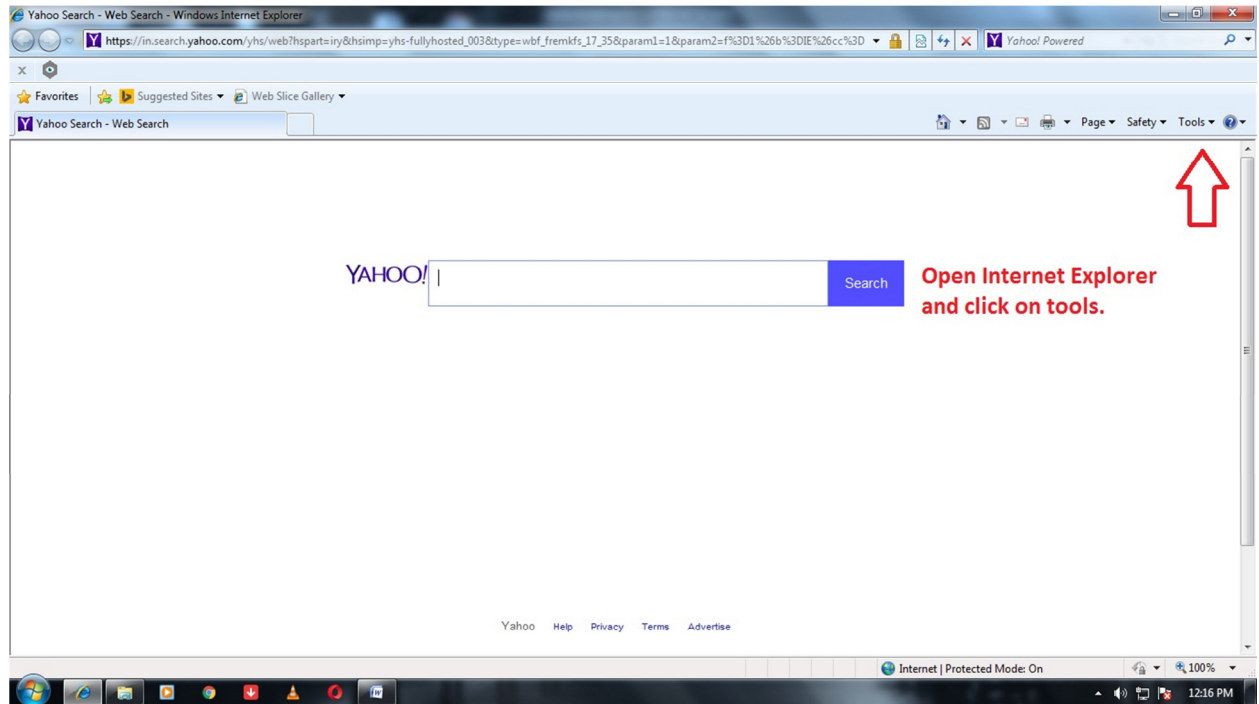


Done! Now click OK

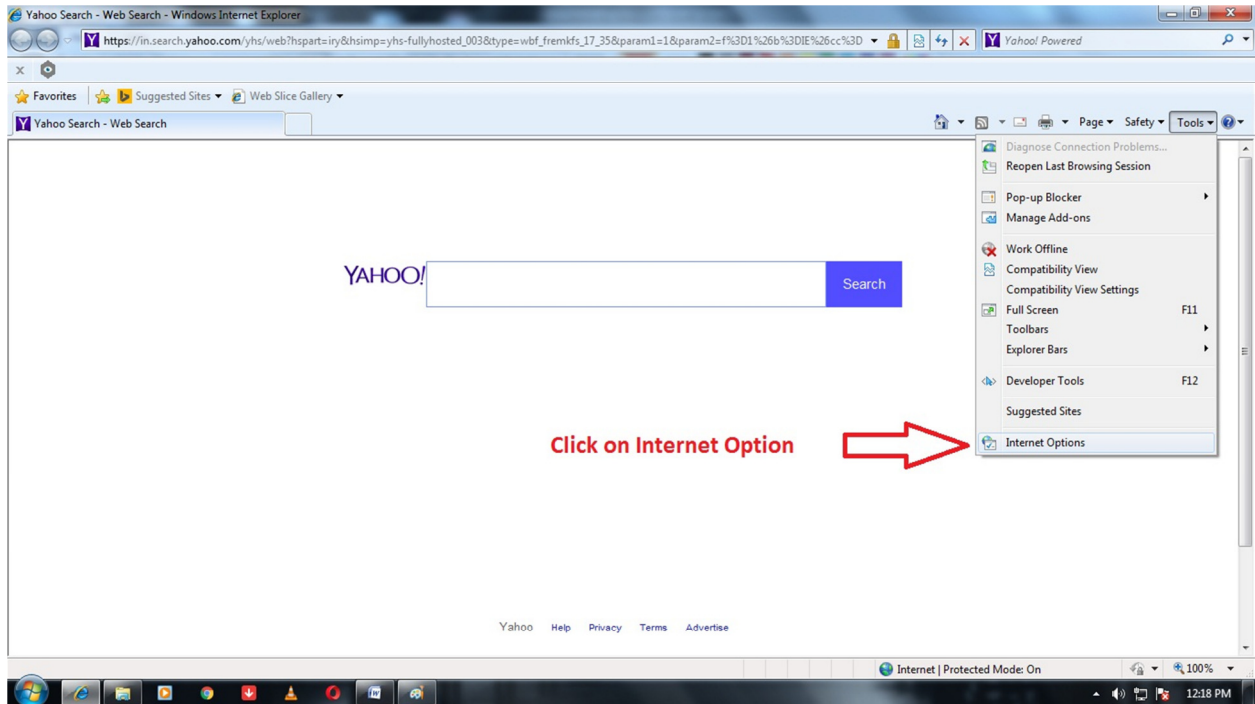
Step 6: Now install "capicom_dc_sdk.msi" file.

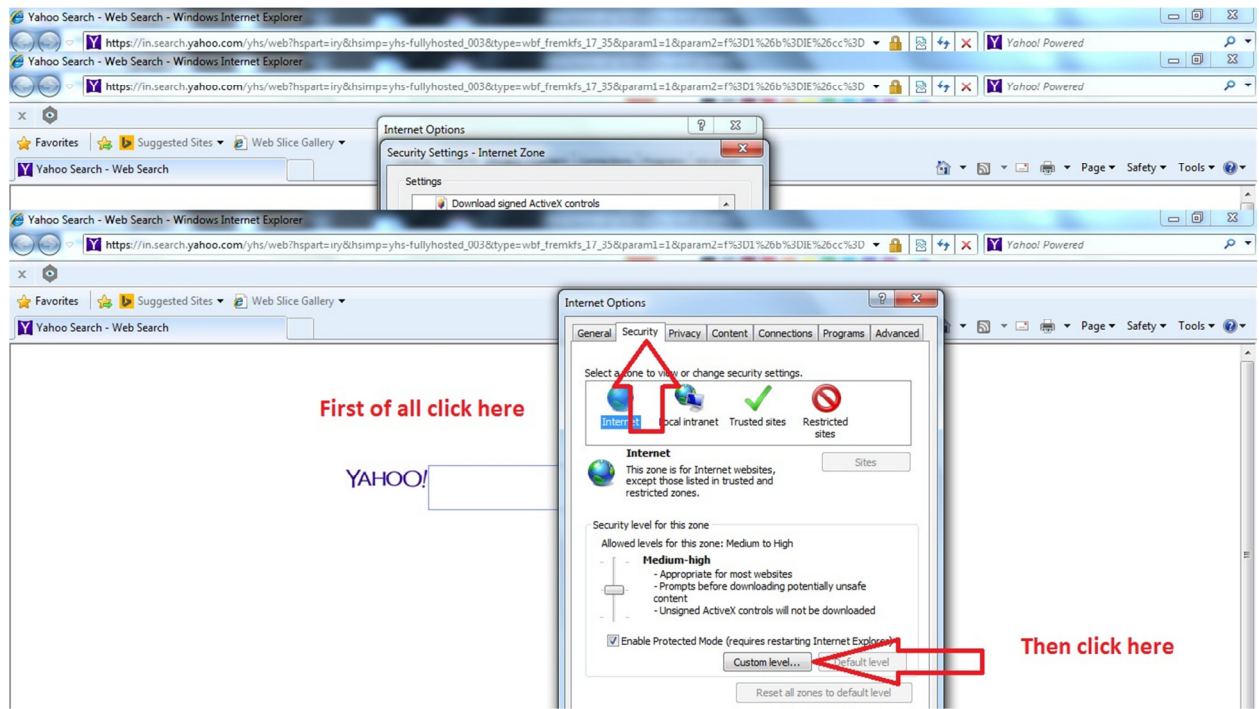


Step 7: Now Open Internet Explorer and click on 'tools' then click on 'Internet Option'.



Step 8: Go to the Security tab and select 'Internet' then click on 'Custom Level'.



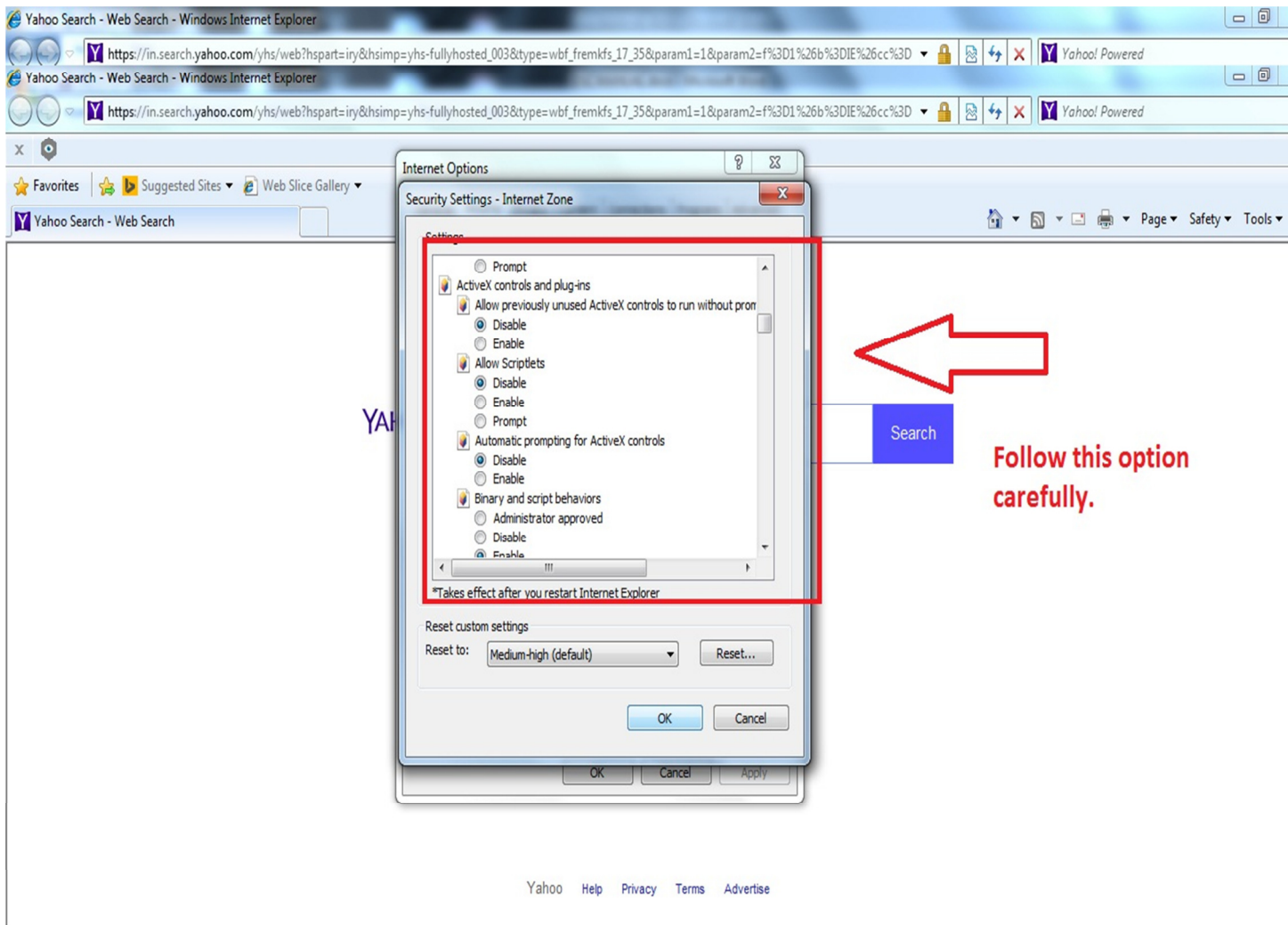

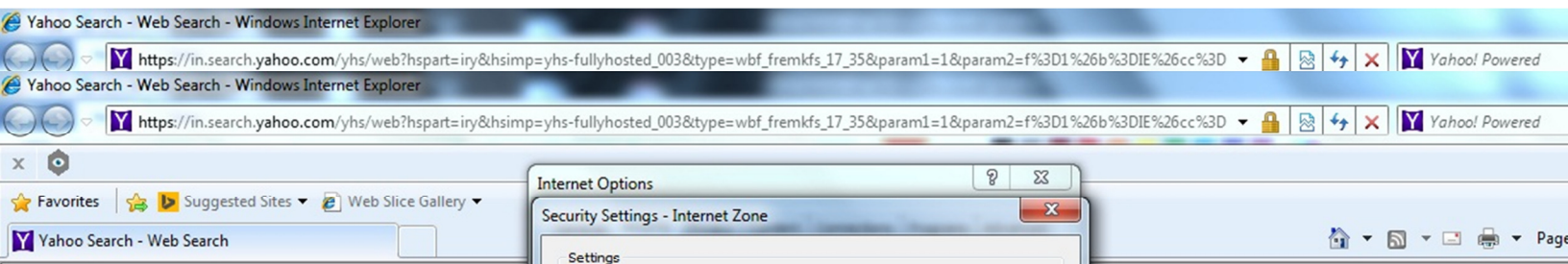
